Election Terms of Reference

- 1. Nomination papers to be a Community Representative should be signed by six residents in the Burngreave New Deal Area and eligible to vote in the Burngreave NDC Elections (i.e. aged 15 or over and on the BNDfC electoral register).
- 2. You must be aged over 18 to be a Member of the Partnership Board (excluding the two places reserved for young people). Therefore all nominees for election as community reps must be aged 18 or over.
- 3. To be nominated for election as a Community Representative you must live in the Burngreave New Deal Area.
- 4. Eligibility to stand for election may be challenged by the Burngreave New Deal for Communities Partnership Board. The procedure for investigating and deciding the outcome of such a challenge shall be the same as where a nomination for election as a City Councillor is challenged on similar grounds.
- 5. Community Representatives take up their duties on a voluntary basis, however, the Burngreave New Deal for Communities Partnership Board can claim expenses incurred while undertaking Burngreave New Deal for Communities Partnership Board business. Expenses include childcare, travel and loss of earnings.
