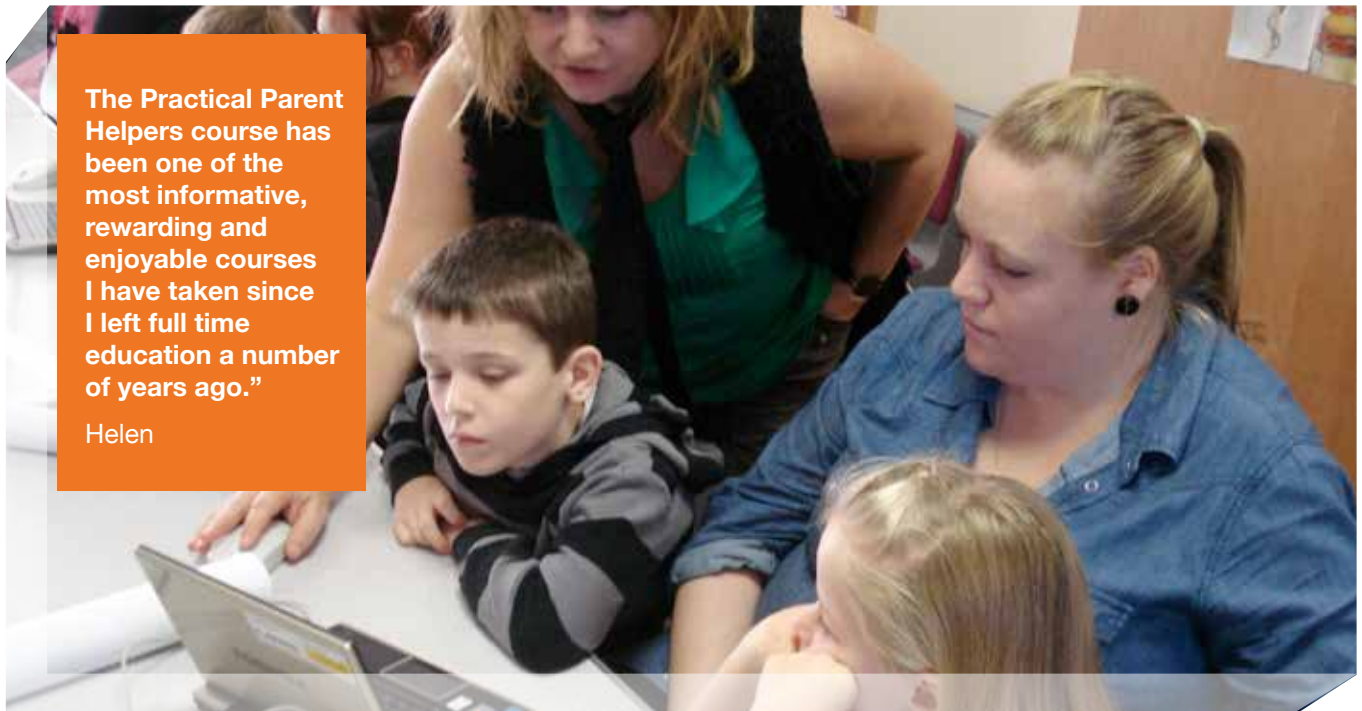


Introduction to Volunteering in Schools
